Dorothy Day, Founder of the Catholic Worker Movement, stated that everything a baptized person does each day should be directly or indirectly related to the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy. One of The Corporal Works of Mercy is feeding the hungry. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVP) is helping feed the hungry with the food pantry located at the St. James the Less Church at 1614 Oakland Park in North Linden. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese pack groceries each evening Monday through Friday. The SVP Conference at St. Timothy contributes financial support and provides teams that volunteer at the St. James Pantry to supply groceries to over 700 needy clients each month. The St. James Food Pantry is located in a Food desert or an urban area in which it is difficult to buy affordable or good quality fresh food. Many clients do not have the transportation to get to a grocery store which is miles away. The pantry provides healthy meals for the families in this impoverished neighborhood.

The St. James Food Pantry is currently in need of the following food supplies:

- Pork and beans
- Tuna

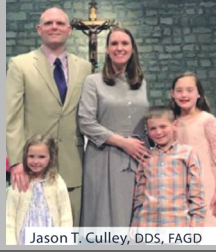
