LIFE IN THE PARISH

Tuesday Morning Bible Study

We have been learning in our recent studies what it takes and how to become a missionary disciple in our secular society. We are now beginning Bishop Robert Barron's video study of the Creed in order to firm up our understanding of what it is we actually profess to believe. We view approximately 25-minute segments of the films and follow with discussion. Please join us Tuesday mornings after the 9:00 a.m. Mass. We meet for an hour in the Teachers' Lounge. Because we are gathering in the part of the building shared by the school, masks are optional.

Lenten Guidelines:

Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Everyone 18 years and older and under 59 years of age is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, only one full meal is allowed. Two other meals sufficient to maintain strength may be taken according to one's needs, but together, they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the rule does not oblige. Catholics should not excuse themselves from these prescribed minimal penitential practices.

For example, recently, SVDP received an assistance request. A domestic violence situation left a mother and her daughters homeless. SVDP helped the family with housing payment after the Section 8 voucher could not cover all the housing costs. The single mother is getting back on her feet and the daughters have been reunited with their mother after being in foster care. Throughout the Bible, God's people are reminded to care for those in need. Even if we don't have much, we should use what we do have to help others. Small things can make a difference. 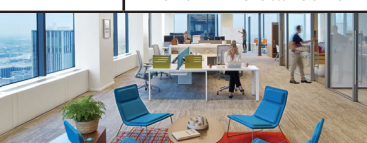

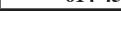
