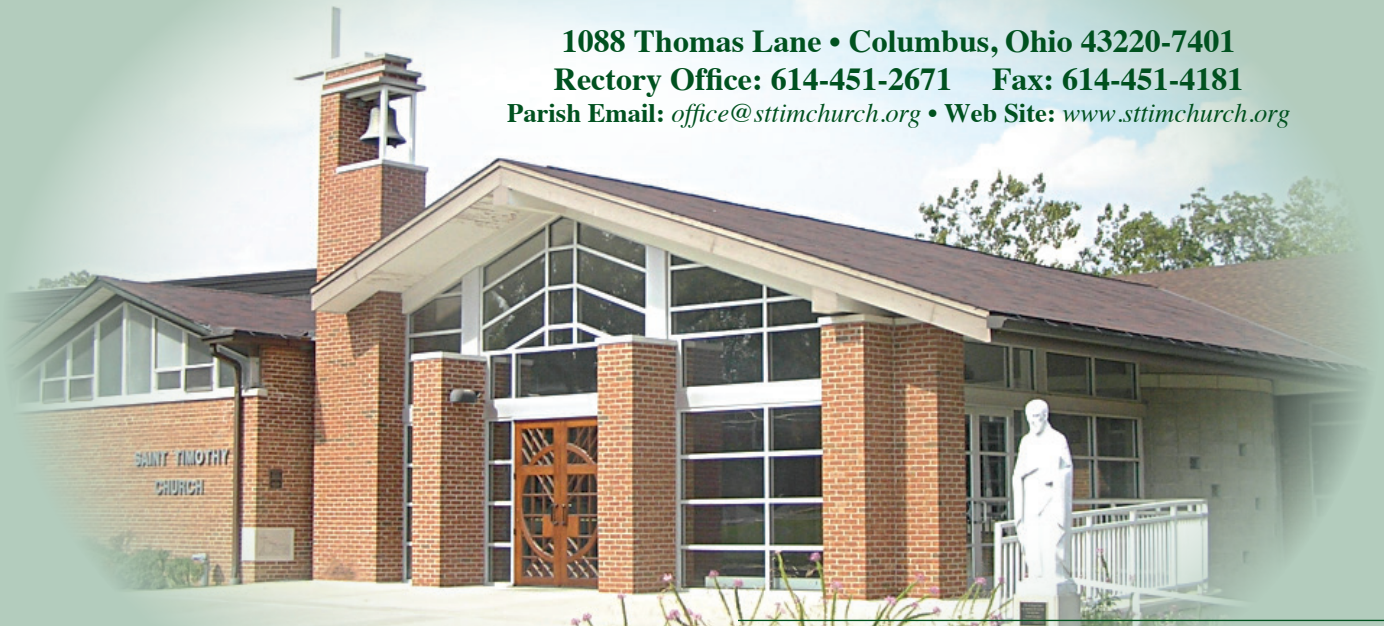

DEACON'S CORNER

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament

"Come to me all of you who are weary, and I will refresh you, take my yoke upon your shoulders and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble of heart, your souls will find rest in me, for my yoke is easy and my burden light."

The Blessed Sacrament is the Sacred Heart of Jesus living and dwelling in our midst, calling us to come to Him. The message of the Sacred Heart is that the Holy Eucharist is not a thing, but a Person, the Person of Our Loving Savior, whose Divine Heart is on fire with deep, personal love for each of us in the Blessed Sacrament.

He said, "I thirst with such a terrible thirst to be loved by you in this Blessed Sacrament. And if you believe in my love in the Blessed Sacrament, if you really believe in my love, then you shall see miracles of my love for I will reign in every heart, in every family, in every country, all over the world. I will establish my kingdom of love and everlasting peace on earth, through the omnipotent, all-powerful love of my Eucharistic heart." (Deuteronomy 30:10-14)

Every Wednesday, we are privileged to have Christ Exposed to us in the Parish Church from 9:00 a.m. Mass until 6:00 p.m., when we close with the Benediction. Do you know that there is only one place in this life that we can see God with our natural eyes, even as sinner, and still live? That place is in the Blessed Sacrament. That is where we meet God face-to-face, talk with Him, can even touch Him, and He listens to us. Jesus is asking us to come and visit Him every Wednesday, even for a short while. Out of the whole week, as we struggle with our life's difficulties, He is asking us to come to Him for help. He is always there to listen to our stories and to lift that burden off our shoulders.

The Bible told the story of the paralytic who was lowered through the ceiling so that Jesus will heal him. Jesus not only healed him, but forgave his sins because of the faith of the people that lowered him through the roof. Bring all your concerns to Him at Adoration, all the problems of your loved ones, all the problems of your neighbors and those you know, and your faith will make them whole. He will solve all their problems because of you.

Come to Benediction and receive God's Blessing. When Christ is raised, He will shower you with His blessings. He is waiting for you in the Blessed Sacrament to receive His blessing. Why don't you give Him a little of your time?

Helping a Family Facing Eviction

Since August of 2020, our St. Timothy Conference has partnered with other Society of St. Vincent de Paul organizations (SVDP) and have assisted 170 families with their past due rent and utilities. Most of these families were facing eviction after struggling to make their monthly rent and utility bills. One recent example was a family with 4 children, ages 10, 5, 2 and a newborn. The family had no income after the father lost his job and the new baby was in the hospital with medical issues. SVDP provided rent assistance to stop eviction proceedings. A new job for the father and a section 8 housing voucher should allow this struggling family to make the rental payments in the future. The family was very grateful for our financial help which allowed them to remain in their home. Thanks to all our SVDP contributors for making a real difference in the lives of the poor.
