

Helping Families Struggling with Food Inflation

Food inflation is hurting the average American family. According to the U.S. Department of Agriculture, food prices increased by 9.9% in 2022 and 7.9% in 2023. These recent increases in food prices are causing great concern for the poor. The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SVDP) is helping address this problem of food inflation with the St. Lawrence Haven operation located at 244 E. Rich Street in downtown Columbus. Volunteers from parishes throughout the diocese make sandwiches and hot meals which feed 300 people each day. The food is distributed Monday through Thursday afternoon at Holy Cross Church. Members of St. Timothy Church make sandwiches for St. Lawrence Haven on the second Sunday of each month, after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, in the school cafeteria.

Due to the increased demand, St. Lawrence Haven is currently struggling to keep food supplies on their shelves and need our help. The items in short supply include granola bars and individually wrapped cookies, crackers and chips. If you would like to donate, please deliver them to the grocery cart in the church lobby as you come to Mass.

We are very thankful for our parish members who donated the much needed linens for the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center. We were able to provide sheets, blankets, towels and washcloths for the clients visiting the SVDP Clothing Distribution Center. Your generous support allows us to continue to provide resources to the people who need it most.
